How do I show up and contribute?



10TH HOUSE

Purpose + Legacy

What legacy will I be known for?


Together, these three houses reveal how your soul is designed to work — what motivates you (2nd), how you serve (6th), and what you're here to build (10th).

2nd House – Money + Resources



The 2nd House represents your personal resources — what you have and how you use it to create stability, comfort, and confidence.

Traditionally known as the House of Money, it speaks to your income potential, self-worth, and material security. But beyond finances, it also reflects your inner resources — your natural talents, skills, and values that support your sense of stability.

When this house is in harmony, money flows as a reflection of confidence and self-trust. When things fall out of alignment, it's a cue to rebuild confidence in your gifts — your outer resources rise to meet your inner sense of worth.

Decoding Your 2nd House

3 Steps to Decoding Your 2nd House

Look at the charts on the next few pages to help with these steps.

STEP 1: Find Your 2nd House Sign

The sign here describes your attitude toward *money, value, and self-worth*.

- **Taurus** → steady and security-oriented
- **Gemini** → flexible, curious, multiple streams of income

STEP 2: Find the Ruler of Your 2nd + Its Placement

Each zodiac sign is ruled by a planet — this planet becomes the “manager” of your money story. Its placement in your chart (by house) shows **where** and **how** your resources are expressed.

- **Example:** If your 2nd House is in Virgo, Mercury rules your finances.
 - If Mercury is in the 5th → income flows through creativity or communication.
 - If Mercury is in the 10th → career reputation directly influences financial stability.

STEP 3: Planets in the 2nd House

Any planets sitting directly in your 2nd house influence your relationship with money, confidence, and possessions. They describe *how you earn, what you value, and what makes you feel secure*.
